

# **Randy Krummenacher (9th) grabs another top 10**

## **Luis Salom (DNF) crashed out in Misano**

**Randy Krummenacher scored today at the GP di San Marino e Riviera Aperol di Rimini again a top 10 place by passing the finish line in ninth position. Luis Salom unfortunately crashed in the sixth lap and was and had to give up in the seventh lap by a broken footrest.**

Randy Krummenacher rode a good warm-up session on Sunday morning equalling his qualifying time of the Saturday. The Swiss ended the session on a good eighth position. Luis Salom didn't have a good session and finished as twelfth.

The start of Randy Krummenacher was okay. From the thirteenth starting position, the Swiss passed the first lap in the same position. The Swiss needed a couple of laps to find his rhythm and started to close the gap to the group fighting for ninth. By the end of the race Krummenacher succeed and was right there with the German Jonas Folger and British Danny Webb. Two laps later the Swiss passed both riders and grabbed the ninth position. In the last lap his old teammate Danny Webb passed Krummenacher but Krummenacher passed the British in the second last turn and finished on a nice ninth position.

The race was short for Luis Salom. With a good start the Spaniard got the connecting with the second group, riding in sixth position. In the fourth turn of the first lap Salom missed his braking point and had to go straight and dropped back to the 20<sup>th</sup> position. Three laps later the Spaniard already recovered the 14<sup>th</sup> place but crashed out one lap later. The footrest of his Aprilia was broken and Salom was forced to end the race in the pit lane.

### **Randy Krummenacher (9<sup>th</sup>):**

"I'm glad I won the battle for ninth place. It was a tough race and it took awhile before I really had found the rhythm. I was riding alone at the eleventh place and concentrated to close the gap to the group who were fighting for ninth. By the end of the race I had the connection and within two laps I passed both riders. In the final lap Danny overtook me but I really wanted to win this battle so I passed him back in the second last turn. Another top 10 result but I want more. The next race I need a better qualifying run so I can fight for sixth place. "

### **Luis Salom (DNF):**

"This was a bad day for me. My start was good but I missed my braking point and dropped back way down in the field. I started to work my way up and a couple of laps later I was already riding in 14<sup>th</sup> place. Unfortunately, I crashed a lap later and I couldn't finish the race. I'm not happy. The next race will be held in my homeland Spain and I want to finish the race there but also want to book a good result. We will see what happens..."
