

**Randy Krummenacher (7^e) grabs a seventh place at
Silverstone
Luis Salom (DNF) crashes out**

During the Air Asia British Grand Prix Randy Krummenacher finished on a seventh position at Silverstone. Teammate Luis Salom didn't make it to the finish line and crashed out in the fifth lap.

Both STIPA-Molenaar Racing GP riders had a good start and were direct involved with the second group. In the first lap Randy Krummenacher past the finish line on a 8th position and teammate Luis Salom crossed the line at the 9th position. Salom was able to follow his fast teammate Krummenacher and with four other riders they were battling for the 7th position. Unfortunately, the Spaniard crashed out in the fifth lap with a high-sider and the Swiss rider continued to catch up the gap with Koyama, which was riding at the fifth place. Krummenacher didn't succeed to close the gap to Koyama and German rider Sandro Cortese catches up with Krummenacher. After Cortese past Krummenacher the rhythm went down.

In the last lap Cortese past Krummenacher and the Swiss missed the sixth place with only a couple of hundreds of a second. Luis Salom had a check-up in the Medical Centrum. After the check-up Salom only had a few scratches and will be 100% fit for the next in Assen which will be the home race of the team.

Randy Krummenacher (7th):

"I'm quite satisfied with the race but before we start the weekend I was expecting a better result. The bike was good only I lost some top speed on the straights but I had good grip in the corners. I tried to catch up with Koyama but he was a bit too fast today. I was leading the pace in the group I was riding but without the slipstream it was difficult for me to close the gap. A seventh position is a good result and I'm looking forward to the home race for the team next weekend in Assen. In this race I want to score a good result!"

Luis Salom (DNF):

"I'm not happy with the crash of today! I had a great start and could hook up with Randy and followed him till I crashed. My bike was very fast and it looked easy to follow Randy and the other riders but then I crashed. Luckily I'm not injured and I'm fit for the next race in Assen. This will be the home race of the team and there I want to be in the top 10."
