

Both riders of STIPA-Molenaar Racing GP in top 10 at Valencia

Both STIPA-Molenaar Racing GP riders managed to finish in the final qualifying of the season once again in the top 10. In the GP Generali de la Comunitat Valenciana Luis Salom grabbed in his home Grand Prix the second row and will start tomorrow's race from the eighth position. Randy Krummenacher came to the tenth starting position and starts the race from the third row.

In the third free practice on Saturday morning Luis Salom rode to a tenth time and Randy Krummenacher closed the session in eleventh place. Both struggled on Friday to chassis problems and they were mainly resolved in the third free practice.

After the training session in the morning the STIPA-Molenaar Racing GP team worked hard to get the chassis tuning to improve even further. This resulted in a nice eighth position for Luis Salom and a tenth place for Randy Krummenacher.

Randy Krummenacher (10th, 1:41.451):

"Today it went much better than yesterday. We are still not on the perfect setting but we are on the right track. I'm satisfied with the tenth starting position, especially given the problems we had. It's also very close and I know that my race pace for tomorrow is good. I want to finish the season with a top-six place and with a good start I think that's possible. "

Luis Salom (8th, 1:41.371):

"I'm a bit disappointed of my last lap. I had a good slipstream behind Marc Marquez and I could follow him well. Unfortunately Sandro Cortese passed me on an aggressive way in the second corner and I lost a lot of time. Ultimately, that cost me two places, but I'm still on the second row. I rode a few times a 41.3 lap and I think when I can hold on this pace in the race it can bring me a top 6. At least I will give everything to end the season with a good result. "
